BY-LAW NO. 27-2003

BEING A BY-LAW TO NAME THE FORMER CENTRAL AVENUE EXIT RAMP OFF THE QEW AS DUTY FREE WAY

WHEREAS Section 11(2) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, provides for spheres of jurisdiction and under Table (1) it states that a lower-tier municipality and an upper-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways, and

WHEREAS Section 47 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that before passing a by-law naming or changing the name of highway, a municipality shall give public notice of its intention to pass the by-law, and

WHEREAS at the Council-in-Committee meeting of January 20, 2003 Report No. F-04-2003 was approved as follows:

- THAT: A by-law be submitted to Council to accept lands generally known as the former Central Avenue Exit Ramp and as shown on the Draft Reference Plan from the Buffalo and Fort Erie Public Bridge Authority for highway purposes, and further
- THAT: The subject lands be named "Duty Free Way", and further
- THAT: The Clerk be directed to publish notice in the local newspaper for two (2) consecutive weeks advising of Council's intentions to pass a by-law to name the subject lands "Duty Free Way", and further
- THAT: A by-law be submitted to Council to authorize the entry into an agreement with the PBA setting out the terms and conditions for the assumption of the exit ramp for highway purposes, maintenance requirements and the like, and further
- THAT: All expenses related to this matter shall be the responsibility of the Peace Bridge Authority, and

WHEREAS at the Regular Council meeting of January 27, 2003 By-law No. 18-2003 was passed authorizing the acceptance of lands generally known as the former Central Avenue Exit Ramp and described as Parts 1, 2 and 3 on Reference Plan 59R-11984 from the Buffalo and Fort Erie Public Bridge Authority for highway purposes, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Council direction as set out under Recommendation No. 13 approved at the Council-in-Committee Meeting of January 20, 2003, notice of the proposed by-law naming the lands as "Duty Free Way" was published once a week for two consecutive weeks in The Times on January 25 and February 1, 2003, and

PROPOSED STREET NAMING - "DUTY FREE WAY"

Pursuant to Section 47 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* notice is hereby given that the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie proposes to pass a by-law to name lands generally known as the former Central Avenue exit ramp off the QEW, just before the approach to the Peace Bridge. The said lands described as Part of Lot 4 on the east side of Wadsworth Street and Part of Wadsworth Street (now Thyret Avenue) according to Registered Plan 9218 for the Village of Fort Erie, now known as Plan 505, and Part of Main Street (now Walden Boulevard), Part of Wadsworth Street, Part of Lane Lying south of Lots 81 to 88, Part of Lots 85, 86, 87, 88, 92, 93 and 114 according to Registered Plan 27 for the Village of Fort Erie now known as Plan 519, all now in the Town of Fort Erie and more particularly described as Part 1 on a Reference Plan to be registered will be conveyed to the Town of Fort Erie by the Buffalo and Fort Erie Public Bridge Authority for public highway purposes.



On Monday, February 10, 2003, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at Town Hall, Fort Erie, the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie intends to consider a by-law to name the above-described lands as "Duty Free Way."

Any person who wishes to appear as a delegation at the Council meeting of February 10, 2003 and to speak to the street naming by-law, should register with the Clerk's Office at Extension 204 by no later than 1:00 p.m. Friday, February 7, 2003.
