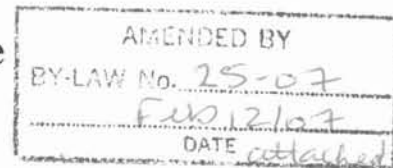
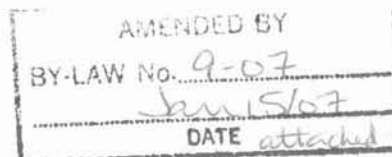

BY-LAW NO. 207-06



BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT PERSONS TO VARIOUS BOARDS AND COMMITTEES OF THE TOWN OF FORT ERIE AND TO REPEAL BY-LAW NOS. 217-03 AND VARIOUS OTHER BY-LAWS

WHEREAS Section 18 of Council Rules of Procedure By-law No. 145-06, as amended, provides for the appointment of members to the authorities, committees, boards and commissions requiring resident, business owner/operator or taxpayer and Council appointments to the various boards and committees of the Town of Fort Erie, and

WHEREAS the term of office for those persons appointed to the Town's various boards and committees by By-law No. 217-03, as amended expired on November 30, 2006, and

WHEREAS Section 18.7 of the said by-law provides the term shall be for two years with a two year option for all boards and committees save and except the Fort Erie Public Library Board (and Committee of Adjustment) whose term shall be concurrent with the Council as provided for under the *Public Libraries Act (and Planning Act)*, and

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 18.3 of By-law No. 145-06, as amended at the meeting of Council-Elect held November 27, 2006 recommendations were made for the appointment of persons to the various boards and committees, and

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to appoint persons to the various boards and committees as well as to enact minor amendments to the Procedural By-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie hereby enacts as follows:

6. **THAT** Section 15 of Appendix "E" to By-law No. 145-06, as amended (Fort Erie Skateboard Ad Hoc Committee) be and it is hereby deleted.
7. **THAT** regardless of the termination date stated herein, all board and committee members shall act, if necessary, on their respective board and committee until new appointments have been made.
8. **THAT** where any by-law conflicts with the provisions herein contained, the provisions of this by-law shall apply.
9. **THAT** By-law No. 145-06 be and it is hereby amended and By-law Nos. 217-03, 9-04, 72-04, 161-04, 178-04, 207-04, 45-05, 117-05, 141-05, 191-05, 200-05, 35-06, 87-06, 121-06, 125-06 be and they are hereby repealed.

BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREA AND
MAYOR'S YOUTH ADVISORY COMMITTEE)**

WHEREAS By-law No. 207-06 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on the 4th day of December, 2006 to provide for appointment of persons to various boards and committees of the Town of Fort Erie, and
