

## The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

BY-LAW NO. 180-08

## BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 173-08 (TO ADOPT THE PRELIMINARY CAPITAL BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF FORT ERIE FOR THE YEAR 2009)

WHEREAS By-law No. 173-08 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2008 to adopt the 2009 Preliminary Capital Budget, save and except the Gradall Equipment for the Roads Fleet in the amount of \$374,220, which was tabled for further consideration at the Council Meeting of December 15, 2008, and

WHEREAS Report No. IS-54-08 was approved at the Council-in-Committee Meeting held December 15, 2008 as follows:

**THAT:**Council approve the preliminary capital budget of a new 2008 Gradall Telescopic boom Excavator with Brusher attachment, and further

**THAT:**Council approve the purchase of a new 2008 Gradall Telescopic Boom Excavator with Brusher attachment pursuant to the provisions of this report, including the trade-in of the 1989 Champion Grader, from Amaco Equipment of Mississauga, Ontario for a total upset limit of \$374,220, excluding G.S.T., and further

**THAT:**The Town's Purchasing and Tendering Policy (By-law No. 29-2002) be and is hereby waived for the purchase of a 2008 Gradall Telescopic Boom Excavator with Brusher attachment for reasons described in this report, and

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to approve and include the aforesaid Gradall in the 2009 Preliminary Capital Budget;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT the Gradall for the Roads Fleet in the amount of \$374,220 be and it is hereby approved as part of the 2009 Preliminary Capital Budget.
- 2. THAT Schedule "A" to By-law No. 173-08 be deleted and replaced with Schedule "A" attached hereto.

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3. THAT pursuant to the provisions of Sections 23.1 to 23.5 inclusive of the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended, the Clerk of the Town of Fort Erie is hereby authorized to effect any minor modifications or corrections solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature or kind to this by-law or its schedules as such may be determined to be necessary after the passage of this by-law.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 15<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF DECEMBER, 2008.
