## By-law No. 131-2015

## Being a By-law to Authorize the Entry into Services Agreements with Niagara Regional Broadband Network Limited for the Provision of Internet and Voice Over Internet Protocol Services

**Whereas** Report No. CAO-20-2015 was considered at the Council-in-Committee meeting held on October 5, 2015, and subsequently authorized by Council, to enter into a five (5) year contract with Niagara Regional Broadband Network Limited (NRBN) for the provision of Internet and Voice Over Internet Protocol (VOIP) services; and

**Whereas** it is deemed desirable to enter into Services Agreements with NRBN for the provision of Internet and VOIP services;

Now therefore the Council of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- That the entry into Services Agreements with Niagara Regional Broadbank Network Limited for the provision of Internet and Voice Over Internet Protocol services for a term of five (5) years with a total cost of \$176,160 plus HST, in a form satisfactory to the Town Solicitor, is authorized and approved.
- 2. That the Mayor and Clerk are authorized and directed to execute the Agreements and all associated documents, and to affix the corporate seal thereto.
- **3.** That the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications or corrections solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.
