



The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law No. 81-2021

Being a By-law to Appoint Chanse Proulx as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie and to Repeal By-law No. 43-2021

Whereas the *Police Services Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.15, section 15 provides that a municipal council may appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality and that municipal law enforcement officers are peace officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal by-laws; and

Whereas the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, section 101 provides that a municipal law enforcement officer may provide evidence in the impoundment of parked vehicles; and

Whereas By-law 43-2021 appointed Ashley Nero as Municipal Law Enforcement Officer and she is no longer in that position; and

Whereas it is deemed desirable to appoint Chanse Proulx as a temporary Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the Town of Fort Erie;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- 1. That** Chanse Proulx is appointed as a temporary Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie and is also appointed as a temporary Provincial Offences Officer while in the discharge of his duties, effective June 23, 2021.
- 2. That** By-law No. 43-2021 is repealed.
- 3. That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 21st day of June, 2021.
