



The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law No. 97-2022

Being a By-law to Establish the Annual Remuneration for Mayor and Members of Council and to Repeal By-law No. 44-12

Whereas By-law No. 44-12 established the remuneration for the Mayor of the Town of Fort Erie at \$54,727.54 for the Years 2012 and 2013, and further established the remuneration for a Councillor to remain at \$12,792.55 for the Years 2012 and 2013; and

Whereas By-law No. 44-12 further provided that in subsequent years, the annual remuneration for the Mayor and Councillors shall be increased on an annual basis according to the annual percentage increase granted to management, supervisory, non-union and exempt employees of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie; and

Whereas the current annual remuneration for Councillors (excluding the Mayor) is \$15,743.40; and

Whereas Report No.CAO-12-1-2022 considered and approved, as amended, by Council at the July 11, 2022 Council-in-Committee meeting authorized the remuneration for Councillors to be adjusted commencing with the 2022 to 2026 term of Council, to \$21,656.00, based upon guiding principles, a living wage calculation and comparison to comparator municipalities;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of theTown of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

1. **That** the annual remuneration for the Mayor of the Town of Fort Erie shall remain at \$72,041.39 for the year 2022.
2. **That** the annual remuneration for a Councillor of the Town of Fort Erie commencing with the term 2022 to 2026 shall be \$21,656.00.
3. **That** in subsequent years, the annual remuneration for the Mayor and Councillors of the Town of Fort Erie shall be increased on an annual basis according to the annual percentage increase granted to management, supervisory, non-union and exempt employees of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie, if that be the case.
4. **That** By-law No. 44-12 is repealed effective November 14, 2022.

5. **That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 18th day of July, 2022.
