



The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law No. 58-2023

Being a By-law to Authorize the Entry into a Licence Agreement with the Crystal Beach Business Improvement Area Board of Management (Farmers' Market – 0 Erie Road)

Whereas By-law No. 63-2021, passed by the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie on May 17, 2021, authorized the entry into a Licence Agreement with the Crystal Beach Business Improvement Area Board of Management (“CBBIA”) for the operation and management of a Farmers’ Market and the use of the Municipal Park known as Queen’s Circle for that purpose; and

Whereas the CBBIA have made a request to relocate the Farmers’ Market from Queen’s Circle to the parking lot located at 0 Erie Road (“the Erie Road Parking Lot”); and

Whereas Report No. CAO-07/LC-04-2023 was considered and approved at the Regular Council Meeting held on March 27, 2023, recommending the relocation of the Crystal Beach Farmers’ Market from Queen’s Circle to the Erie Road Parking Lot for the 2023 season; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary to enter into a new Licence Agreement with the Crystal Beach Business Improvement Area Board of Management for the operation and management of the Farmers’ Market and the use of the Erie Road Parking Lot for that purpose;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

1. **That** the entry into a Licence Agreement with the Crystal Beach Business Improvement Area Board of Management for the operation and management of a Farmers’ Market and the use of the Erie Road Parking Lot for that purpose, in a form satisfactory to the Chief Administrative Officer, is authorized and approved.
2. **That** the Mayor and Clerk are authorized and directed to execute the Licence Agreement and to affix the corporate seal thereto.
3. **That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to affect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 24th day of April, 2023.
