



The Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie

By-law 123-2023

Being a By-law to Appoint Shaela Frado as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer and Repeal By-law 109-2023

Whereas subsection 15(1) of the *Police Services Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.15, provides that a municipal council may appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality; and

Whereas subsection 15(2) of the said *Act* further provides that municipal law enforcement officers are peace officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal by-laws; and

Whereas subsection 1(1) of the *Provincial Offences Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P33, provides that "provincial offences officer" means a municipal law enforcement officer while in the discharge of his or her duties; and

Whereas subsection 1(1) of the *Building Code Act*, 1992, S.O. 1992, c.23 provides that an "officer" means a "property standards officer" who has been assigned the responsibility of administering and enforcing by-laws under section 15.1 of the *Act*; and

Whereas By-law 109-2023 appointed Gary Murphy as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie and he no longer works for the Town; and

Whereas it is deemed desirable to appoint Shaela Frado as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the Town of Fort Erie;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- 1. That** Shaela Frado is appointed as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie and is also appointed as a Provincial Offences Officer while in the discharge of her duties, effective July 31, 2023.
- 2. That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to effect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 24th day of July 2023.
