

The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie By-law 54-2024

Being a By-law to Appoint Temporary Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the 2024 Summer Season

Whereas the *Police Services Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.15, section 15 provides that a municipal council may appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality and that municipal law enforcement officers are peace officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal by-laws; and

Whereas the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, section 101 provides that a municipal law enforcement officer may provide evidence in the impoundment of parked vehicles; and

Whereas it is deemed desirable to appoint temporary Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the 2023 summer season.

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- 1. That each of the following persons is appointed a temporary Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie and is also appointed a temporary Provincial Offences Officer while in the discharge of their duties until on or about September 30, 2024 or as may be extended by the Chief Administrative Officer:
 - a. Brandon Gordon
 - b. Connor Connaughton
 - c. Joel Coopman
 - d. Cody Willard
- 2. That this By-law shall come into force and effect on April 30, 2024.
- **3.** That the Clerk of the Town is authorized to affect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 27th day of May 2024.
