

## The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie By-law 75-2024

## Being a By-law Assume Primary Services for Crystal Ridge Landing Subdivision Phases 1, 2 & 3 (59M-465) 1372708 Ontario Inc. (Vaughn Gibbons) – Owner

**Whereas** By-law No. 114-2017, as amended by By-law 29-2019, authorized the Mayor and Clerk to execute the Subdivision Agreement and Amending Subdivision Agreement, respectively, for Crystal Ridge Landing Subdivision; and

**Whereas** Section 10.8 of the Subdivision Agreement provides that municipal services shall be assumed by the Town in two stages, namely, by Council first passing an Assumption By-law for Primary Services after the Director of Infrastructure Services approves the Certificate of Final Acceptance for Primary Services, and second, an Assumption By-law for Secondary Services after the Director of infrastructure Services approves the Certificate of Final Acceptance for Secondary Services; and

**Whereas** the Director of Infrastructure Services has approved the Certificates of Final Acceptance for Primary Services for Phases 1, 2, & 3 of the said subdivision; and

Whereas it is deemed desirable to assume the Primary Services of the said subdivision;

**Now therefore** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- **1. That** the following Primary Services identified on the approved servicing plans associated with the Subdivision registered as Plan 59M-465 are assumed by the Town of Fort Erie, namely:
  - a) Water Distribution System and appurtenances; and
  - b) Sanitary Service Laterals and appurtenances; and
  - c) Storm Sewer main and appurtenances, and
  - d) Base roads and curbs; and
  - e) Street light distribution system,

pursuant to the Certificates of Final Acceptance for Primary Services.

2. That the Clerk of the Town is authorized to affect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of July 2024.
