



The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie By-law 60-2025

Being a By-law to Authorize Amending the Memorandum of Understanding between Hospice Niagara and The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie (Increase Grant Funding)

Whereas By-law 94-2021 was passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on August 23, 2021, to approve the entry into a Memorandum of Understanding with Hospice Niagara for a \$150,000 grant request to be paid over three years, beginning in 2021; and

Whereas the Town entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with Hospice Niagara dated August 25, 2021; and

Whereas at the Regular Council Meeting held on April 28, 2025, Hospice Niagara requested that the Town increase the contribution by \$100,000, bringing the total support to \$250,000; and

Whereas at the Regular Council Meeting held on April 28, 2025, Council considered and approved Resolution 1 to amend the 2025 General Levy Operating Budget to increase grant funding to Hospice Niagara by \$100,000 with funding from the Community Health & Wellness Reserve; and

Whereas it is deemed desirable to Amend the Memorandum of Understanding to increase the Town's grant funding to Hospice Niagara to \$250,000.

Now, therefore, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- 1. That** the Mayor and Clerk are authorized and directed to execute the amending Memorandum of Understanding with Hospice Niagara for the increase of \$100,000 in grant funding in a form satisfactory to the Town Solicitor and to affix the corporate seal thereto.
- 2. That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to affect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 23rd day of June 2025.
