

The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie By-law 88-2025

Being a By-law to appoint a Municipal Livestock Valuer and Investigator for the Town of Fort Erie, and to repeal By-law 120-09

Whereas the Order in Council No. 502-2016 regulating the Ontario Wildlife Damage Compensation Program, requires that the council of every local municipality shall appoint one or more persons as Municipal Investigators to investigate injury or death to Livestock and/or Poultry caused by wildlife, as set out in section 7(6) of the *Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs Act*; and

Whereas Section 4 of the *Protection of Livestock and Poultry from Dogs Act* requires that the council of every local municipality shall appoint one or more persons as valuers of livestock and poultry for the purposes of this Act; and

Whereas the Town's current Livestock Valuer, Deborah Wright, as appointed by By-law 120-09, has resigned; and

Whereas the Livestock Investigator and Valuer for the Township of Wainfleet, Garry Balicki, has agreed to provide this service as needed for the Town of Fort Erie.

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- **1. That** Garry Balicki be appointed as the Livestock Valuator for the Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie and shall become effective on the date of passing of this By-law.
- **2. That** the Livestock Valuer and Investigator be reimbursed by the Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie \$100.00 plus mileage at the Town's corporate rate for each investigation.
- **3.** That By-law 120-09 be repealed.
- **4. That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to affect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 20th day of October 2025.
