



The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie By-law 8-2025

Being a By-law to Authorize the Entry into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Fort Erie Public Library for the use of electrical services – 89 Ridge Road South (Crystal Ridge Library)

Whereas the property located at 89 Ridge Road South, Ridgeway, Ontario (Crystal Ridge Library) is owned by the Town of Fort Erie and leased to the Fort Erie Public Library for library operations and under the existing arrangement, the Library is responsible for managing and maintaining the hydro account for the property through Canadian Niagara Power; and

Whereas municipally owned electric vehicle (EV) charging stations were installed at this location and will draw electricity from the Library's hydro service; and

Whereas Report No. PBBS-01-2026 was considered and approved at the Council-in-Committee meeting held on January 12, 2026, authorizing the entering into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Fort Erie Public Library for the use of electrical services for the operation of existing and future municipally owned electric vehicle (EV) charging stations at library locations; and

Whereas it is deemed desirable to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Fort Erie Public Library for the use of electrical services;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- 1. That** the entry into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Fort Erie Public Library, for the use of electrical services for the operation of existing and future municipally owned EV charging stations, in the form of Schedule "A" appended hereto this by-law, is authorized and approved.
- 2. That** the Mayor and Clerk are authorized and directed to execute the Memorandum of Understanding, in the form of Schedule "A" appended hereto, and to affix the corporate seal thereto, and all other documentation necessary to effect the terms and conditions of same.
- 3. That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to affect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 26th day of January, 2026.
