



The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie By-law 10-2026

Being a By-law to Amend By-law 135-2017 to Update the Delegation of Authority for Tax Collection Powers and Duties

Whereas By-law 135-2017 was passed by the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie on December 11, 2017, to delegate tax collection powers and duties of the Treasurer; and

Whereas the positions of *Manager, Revenue and Collections and Senior Revenue Clerk II - Tax* referenced in By-law 135-2017 no longer exists due to organizational restructuring; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary to amend By-law 135-2017 to reflect the current staffing structure and to ensure the continued and effective delegation of authority with respect to tax collection powers and duties;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- 1. That** Section 1 of By-law 135-2017 be amended by deleting the words "*Manager, Revenue and Collections and Senior Revenue Clerk II – Tax*" and replacing them with the words: "*Supervisor of Revenue and Collections and Senior Revenue Clerk – Taxation*".
- 2. That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to affect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 26th day of January 2026.
