



## The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie By-law 23-2026

---

### Being a By-law to Amend By-law 2000-89, as amended, to Regulate Traffic and Parking on Highways, and By-law 84-2014, as amended, to Establish a System for Administrative Penalties Respecting the Stopping, Standing and Parking of Vehicles within the Town of Fort Erie (Housekeeping Amendments)

---

**Whereas** Section 11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, authorizes municipalities to pass by-laws respecting highways, including traffic and parking; and

**Whereas** Subsection 102.1(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that a municipality may require a person to pay an administrative penalty if the municipality is satisfied that the person failed to comply with any by-laws respecting the parking, standing or stopping of vehicles; and

**Whereas** Council has established a system of administrative penalties pursuant to By-law 84, 2014, as amended, in accordance with Ontario Regulation 333/07, as amended, and has designated certain provisions of By-law 2000-89, as amended, for enforcement under that system; and

**Whereas** Council approved By-law 2000-89, as amended, to regulate traffic and parking within the municipality; and

**Whereas** Council approved By-law 84-2014, as amended, to establish a system for Administrative Monetary Penalties (AMPs) respecting the stopping, standing and parking of vehicles within the Town of Fort Erie; and

**Whereas** Council approved Report PBBS-08-2026 Proposed Parks and Beaches By-law on February 23, 2026, authorizing the preparation of a revised Parks and Beaches By-law; and

**Whereas** a review of By-law 84-2014, as amended, and By-law 2000-89, as amended, was required which resulted in the identification of clerical errors, inconsistencies, omissions, incorrect cross-references, and redundancies between provisions and schedules respecting provisions subject to the AMPs by-law; and

**Whereas** it is deemed necessary and desirable to correct such errors and discrepancies, improve clarity, ensure internal consistency, and facilitate effective enforcement of By-law 84-2014, as amended, and By-law 2000-89, as amended; and

**Whereas** these amendments are administrative in nature and do not materially alter the intent or scope of By-law 84-2014, as amended, or By-law 2000-89, as amended.

**Now therefore** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

1. **That** By-law 2000-89, as amended, be further amended by adding the phrase:

“in any of the following locations:”

immediately after the word “highway” in the following sections:

- Section 203.01
- Section 203.02
- Section 205.01

2. **That** By-law 2000-89, as amended, be further amended by repealing Section 209.06.04 and replacing it as follows:

“209.06.04 No person shall park a vehicle in an individual parking space or parking lot where a parking meter has been installed without payment as required in accordance with the provisions set out in Schedule “G” of this By-law.”

3. **That** By-law 2000-89, as amended, be further amended by repealing Schedule “AD” and replaced it with a new Schedule “AD” titled “Provisions Subject to Administrative Penalties”, attached hereto as Schedule “A”.

4. **That** By-law 84-2014, as amended, be further amended by repealing Section 2 (Definitions), and replacing it with the following:

#### **“DEFINITIONS**

2.1 The following terms are defined for the purposes of this by-law:

- 2.1.1 **“Administrative Fee”** mean a fee imposed by the Town under this By-law to recover the costs of administering the administrative penalty system, including but not limited to late payment fees, screening or hearing no-show fees, and plate denial processing fees, as set out in Schedule “E”.
- 2.1.2 **“Administrative Penalty”** means a monetary penalty imposed by the Town under this By-law for a contravention of a Designated By-law, the amount of which is set out in Schedules “A”, “B”, “C” and “D”.
- 2.1.3 **“By-law”** means this by-law and any schedule to this by-law as they may from time to time be amended.
- 2.1.4 **“Council”** means the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie.
- 2.1.5 **“Designated By-law”** means a by-law with respect to the parking, standing or stopping of vehicles that is designated by the Town as a by-law to which this Administrative Penalty By-law applies and includes any designated provision of such by-law and which is listed in Schedules “A”, “B”, “C” and “D” attached to this By-law.
- 2.1.6 **“Director”** means the Director of Planning, Building and By-law Services from time to time or the holder of the office exercising the functions presently performed by the said Director and includes or his or her designate.
- 2.1.7 **“Fee – Appeal Hearing – No Show”** means the Administrative Fee imposed where a Person fails to appear at the time and place scheduled for a hearing before a Hearing Officer.
- 2.1.8 **“Fee – Late Payment”** means the Administrative Fee imposed where a Person fails to pay an Administrative Penalty within the time prescribed by this By-law.
- 2.1.9 **“Fee – MTO Plate Denial”** means the Administrative Fee imposed for notifying the Registrar of Motor Vehicles for the purpose of plate permit denial.
- 2.1.10 **“Fee – NSF”** means the Administrative Fee imposed where payment of an Administrative Penalty or Administrative Fee is returned due to insufficient funds.
- 2.1.11 **“Fee – MTO Search”** means an Administrative Fee from time to time established by Council for searching the records of the Ontario Ministry of Transportation and listed in Schedule “E”.

- 2.1.12 “Fee – Screening No-Show”** means the Administrative Fee imposed where a Person fails to appear at the time and place scheduled for a review before a Screening Officer.
- 2.1.13 “Hearing Officer”** means a person appointed by Council to conduct hearings and decide appeals under this By-law.
- 2.1.14 “Officer”** means each of:
- i. the Director;
  - ii. a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer appointed by or under the authority of a Town by-law to enforce a Designated By-law; and
  - iii. a police officer employed by the Niagara Regional Police, by the Ontario Provincial Police, or the Royal Canadian Mounted Police.
- 2.1.15 “O. Reg. 333/07”** means Ontario Regulation 333/07, pursuant to made under the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c 25, as amended or replaced from time to time.
- 2.1.16 “Owner”** means the registered owner of a motor vehicle as indicated in the records of the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario (MTO).
- 2.1.17 “Penalty Notice”** means a notice given pursuant to Subsections 4.1 and 4.2.
- 2.1.18 “Penalty Notice Date”** means the date specified on the Penalty Notice pursuant to Subsection 4.3 (b).
- 2.1.19 “Penalty Notice Number”** means the number specified on the Penalty Notice pursuant to Subsection 4.3 (c).
- 2.1.20 “Person”** includes an individual, partnership, association, firm or corporation.
- 2.1.21 “Request for Screening Form”** means the form required to request a review by a Screening Officer under this By-law
- 2.1.22 “Request for Hearing Form”** means the form required to request a hearing before a Hearing Officer under this By-law.
- 2.1.23 “Screening Decision”** means a decision made by a Screening Officer following a review under Section 5 of this By-law.
- 2.1.24 “Screening Officer”** means a person appointed by the Town to conduct reviews of Administrative Penalties in accordance with this By-law.”

**5. That** By-law 84-2014, as amended, be further amended by repealing Section 3.1 and replacing it as follows:

“3.1 Town By-laws, or portions of Town By-laws, that are listed in Schedules “A” ,“B” , “C” and “D” to this By-law are hereby designated as Designated By-laws and are hereby designated for the purpose of Subsection 3(1)(b) of O. Reg. 333/07 and the provisions of this By-law shall apply to any contravention of a Designated By-law. Schedules "A", "B", "C" and “D”, shall set out the short form wording to be used for the contraventions of Designated By-laws and also set out the Administrative Penalties imposed for the contraventions.”

**6. That** By-law 84-2014, as amended, be further amended by repealing Subsection 4.2.1 and replacing it as follows:

“4.2.1 The Director may cancel an Administrative Penalty where it is determined that the Penalty Notice was issued in error or contains an administrative defect.”

7. **That** By-law 84-2014, as amended, be further amended by repealing Section 5.1 and replacing it as follows:  

“5.1 A Person who is given a Penalty Notice may request that the Administrative Penalty be reviewed by a Screening Officer and may request an extension of the time to request such a review in accordance with this By-law.”
8. **That** By-law 84-2014, as amended, be further amended by adding the following as Section 5.9:  

“5.9 Where a Screening Officer grants an extension of time to request a Screening Review or to pay an Administrative Penalty, any enforcement measures available to the Town under this By-law or under the Designated By-laws shall be suspended until the expiry of the extended deadline.”
9. **That** Section 5.9 and all subsequent sections of By-law 84-2014, as amended, are renumbered in sequential order.
10. **That** By-law 84-2014, as amended, be further amended by adding the following as Section 6.12:  

“6.12 Where a Hearing Officer grants an extension of time to request a hearing or to pay an Administrative Penalty, any enforcement measures available to the Town under this By-law or under the Designated By-laws shall be suspended until the expiry of the extended deadline.”
11. **That** Section 6.12 and all subsequent sections of By-law 84-2014, as amended, are renumbered in sequential order.
12. **That** By-law 84-2014, as amended, be further amended by adding the following as Subsection 8.2 a):  

“a) Any Administrative Fee imposed under this By-law forms part of the Administrative Penalty owing and may be enforced in the same manner as an Administrative Penalty.”
13. **That** By-law 84-2014, as amended, be further amended by repealing Schedules “A”, “B”, “C” and “D” and replacing it with new Schedules “A”, “B”, “C” and “D” attached hereto as Schedule “B”.
14. **That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to affect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March 2026.
