



The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie By-law 34-2026

Being a By-law to Appoint Temporary Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the 2026 Summer Season

Whereas section 15 of the *Police Services Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.15, provides that a municipal council may appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality and that municipal law enforcement officers are peace officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal bylaws; and

Whereas section 101 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, provides that a municipal law enforcement officer may provide evidence and the impoundment of parked vehicles; and

Whereas it is deemed desirable to appoint temporary Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the 2026 summer season;

Now therefore the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

1. **That** each of the following individuals is appointed a temporary Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie and is also appointed a temporary Provincial Offences Officer while in the discharge of their duties until on or about September 30, 2026, or as may be extended by the Chief Administrative Officer:
 - i. Cody Willard
 - ii. Joel Coopman
 - iii. Zayn Dehghan
 - iv. Cooper Bailey
2. **That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to affect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 27th day of April 2026.
