



## The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie By-law 49-2026

### Being a By-law to Authorize the Entry into a Downtown Stevensville Core Area Community Improvement Plan Grant Program Funding Agreement with Amanda Vollmer – 3727 West Main Street

---

**Whereas** By-law 07-2016 passed by the Municipal Council of the Town of Fort Erie on January 18, 2016, adopted a Downtown Stevensville Core Area Community Improvement Plan; and

**Whereas** Amanda Vollmer has made an application to the Town for a grant under the Commercial Façade Grant Program and the Commercial Façade Signage Grant Program in accordance with the Downtown Stevensville Core Area Community Improvement Plan; and

**Whereas** Report PBBS-26-2026 was considered and approved at the Council-in Committee Meeting held on June 8, 2026, to authorize entry into an Agreement with Amanda Vollmer under the Program; and

**Whereas** it is deemed desirable to enter into an Agreement with Amanda Vollmer for the redevelopment at 3727 West Main Street;

**Now therefore** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Fort Erie enacts as follows:

- 1. That** the entry into a Downtown Stevensville Core Area Community Improvement Plan Grant Program Funding Agreement for the redevelopment of 3727 West Main Street, is authorized and approved.
- 2. That** the Mayor and Clerk are authorized and directed to execute the Downtown Stevensville Core Area Community Improvement Plan Grant Program Funding Agreement, in the form satisfactory to the Town's Solicitor, and to affix the corporate seal thereto.
- 3. That** the Clerk of the Town is authorized to affect any minor modifications, corrections or omissions, solely of an administrative, numerical, grammatical, semantical or descriptive nature to this by-law or its schedules after the passage of this by-law.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of June 2026.
